VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-04

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITION OF CORPORAL OF THE ADDYSTON POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is appropriate to make adjustments in the rate of pay of certain Village employees; and

WHEREAS, the compensation for the position of corporal was omitted from the prior pay raise ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined it is necessary to adjust the compensation of the corporal position; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the current rates of pay for the following specified positions shall be adjusted as follows:


Addyston Police Corporal \$14.77 per hour

SECTION 2. That the rates of pay set forth at Section 1, above, shall be effective as of April 21, 2008.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall supersede and take precedence over any previously enacted ordinance or legislation pertaining to the rates of pay of the above-listed employees effective as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to provide adequate and realistic compensation to Village employees.
