ORDINANCE NO. 2013-07

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING DOOR TO
DOOR SOLICITORS AND PEDDLERS WITHIN THE
VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON, OHIO**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined the need to regulate door to door sales persons within the Village of Addyston to protect the citizens of the Village and permit the tax department to implement ordinances related to the collection of taxes; now therefore

Section 1. **LICENSE REQUIRED.** No person shall engage in business on the public streets and avenues of the Village as a door to door solicitor, peddler, or hawker of produce or other goods, not of his or her raising or manufacture until such person has obtained a license as provided in this ordinance.

Section 2. **LICENSE NONTRANSFERABLE; EXCEPTION.** Licenses issued under the provisions of this chapter shall not be in any manner assignable or transferable, or shall authorize any other business than is therein mentioned, or any other person than is therein named to do business, without the permission of the Village Clerk thereon endorsed.

Section 3. **ISSUANCE OF LICENSE; REVOCATION.** A door to door, peddler or hawker's license shall be issued by the Village Clerk, and shall specify by name the person or firm to which and the business for which it is granted. Every door to door sales person, peddler or hawker while engaged in business shall carry his license and shall exhibit same whenever requested by any citizen or Village officer.

If at any time it shall be made to appear to the satisfaction of the Village Clerk that any licensed person has violated any of the provisions of this ordinance, the Village Clerk shall revoke the license, and the licensed person shall cease to have any authority thereunder.

Section 4. **TERM OF LICENSE.** All licenses shall be operative for a period of one year from the date of issue.

Section 5. **LICENSE FEE.** Door to door sales persons, peddlers or hawkers of produce, fruit, vegetables, meat, fish, game, poultry, oysters, groceries, dairy products or goods or articles of any kind from vehicles drawn by animal or motive power, and those selling goods from hand carts or packs carried by two or more persons, or soliciting business door to door of every kind shall pay a license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per year.


Section 6. **HOURS OF SOLICITATION.** The hours of business for any door to

door sales person, peddler, or hawker operating their business in the Village of Addyston shall be between 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. from May 1 through Labor Day and between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. from Labor Day through April 30.


Section 7. PENALTY. Any person peddling or hawking goods without having a valid license then in effect or any person failing or refusing to exhibit the license on demand, or any person who violates any other provision of this chapter, shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

Section 8. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the protection of the residents of the Village and the enforcement of ordinances within the Village.

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-08

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE
CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES
OF THE VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON, OHIO DURING THE
CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2013

WHEREAS, Village Council desires to amend the appropriations for the Village prior to December 31, 2013 to comply with state law; now therefore


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Addyston during the calendar year ending December 31, 2013, the sums be and are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certifications and vouchers therefor approved by the Board of Officers and/or Village Council authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of or in accordance with the law and ordinances; provided further that the appropriations for incidental expenses can only be expended for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations made herein or approved by the appropriate Village officers.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed forthwith and to amend the current appropriations to comply with state law.
