

VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - B

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE CLERK TO TERMINATE THE VILLAGE'S AGREEMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR THE COLLECTION OF EARNINGS TAXES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON AND FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE ADDYSTON EARNINGS TAX OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Village of Addyston requires the services of a Tax Commissioner to administer its earnings tax ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to reassess its participation in a Regional Council of Governments pursuant to Chapter 167 of the Ohio Revised Code for the purpose of a collection facility for the purpose of administering the Addyston income tax laws and the collection of earnings taxes on behalf of the Village of Addyston; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Addyston, Ohio, desires to terminate its relationship with R.I.T.A. for the collection and enforcement of the Village's Earnings Tax Ordinance effective January 1, 2014; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized to terminate the Village's agreement with the Regional Council of Government and/or R.I.T.A. to administer, enforce, collect, and otherwise perform any and all acts required for the enforcement of the Addyston earnings tax ordinance.

SECTION 2. That all documents generated by the Regional Council of Government during the period it or any subagency of the Regional Council of Government administered, enforced, collected, or otherwise performed any and all acts required for the enforcement of the Addyston earnings tax ordinance shall be preserved and said records shall remain confidential until the appointment of a new tax commissioner.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance an a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is that the Village requires the services of a Tax Commissioner at once to effectively enforce the Addyston Earnings Tax Ordinance.
