

VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2014- 02

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE  
VILLAGE CLERK TO ENTER INTO A  
CONTRACT FOR THE LEASE/PURCHASE  
OF TWO 2014 FORD INTERCEPTORS

**WHEREAS**, a real and present emergency exists because of the deteriorated condition of the existing police cruisers that make them unreliable or prohibitively expensive to repair; and

**WHEREAS**, the police chief recommends the lease/purchase of two- 2014 FORD INTERCEPTOR utilities with police package vehicles for use by the Village police department; and

**WHEREAS**, Addyston Village Council recognizes the need for the lease/purchase of two- 2014 FORD INTERCEPTORS motor vehicles to be used by the Village police department; now therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the lease/purchase of two- 2014 FORD INTERCEPTOR motor vehicles and accessories in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Village Clerk. (See Exhibit A attached). The motor vehicles are being purchased through the state bid program.

**SECTION 2.** That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw and pay warrants for the foregoing purpose out of the General Fund.



The reason for said emergency is the necessity to ensure the safety of the citizens and employees of the Village.
