Cooperative Agreement for Participation in
Hamilton County Community Development Program

ORDINANCE/ RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR/MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT OF
COOPERATION WITH HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO PURSUANT TO PROVISIONS OF THE HOUSING AND
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has enacted the Housing and Community Development
Act of 1974 which has as its primary objective the development of viable communities; and

WHEREAS, Hamilton County qualifies under said Act as an urban county eligible to receive federal
block grant funding for support of community development activities; and

WHEREAS, said Act provides for and encourages units of local government to enter into agreements of
cooperation with urban counties for purposes of undertaking essential community development and housing
assistance activities; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Addyston Ohio desires to enter into a cooperative agreement with
Hamilton County for Federal Fiscal Years 2015, 2016, and 2017 of the Community Development Program;
NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED/RESOLVED by the Council of Addyston, Hamilton County, Ohio:

SECTION I. That the Mayor/Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Cooperation Agreement with
the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County, Ohio, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto
and made a part hereof.

SECTION II. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; the reason for the emergency being
the filing deadline established by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for Community
Development Block Grant applications, and shall therefore take effect and be in effect immediately upon
passage.
