

VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON
ORDINANCE NO. 2014- 11

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF
STAFF SERGEANT WITH THE VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON
POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code authorizes a Village to determine the complement of the Village Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Village to establish the position of staff sergeant within the Village Police Department; now therefor

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby established the position of Staff Sergeant within the Village of Addyston Police Department.

SECTION 2. That the hourly compensation for the position of police chief shall be \$17.82 per hour effective August 29, 2014.

SECTION 3. That the Staff Sergeant shall be the second in command of the Addyston Police Department in the absence of the Chief of Police.


SECTION 4. That the Staff Sergeant shall not receive any additional compensation when serving as the head of the Addyston Police Department in the absence of the Chief of Police.

SECTION 5 That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the protection of the residents of the Village, the enforcement of ordinances within the Village, and provide for a second in command of the Addyston Police Department.
