ORDINANCE NO. 2014- 12

AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE POSITION OF  
LIEUTENANT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON  
POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code authorizes a Village to determine the complement of the Village Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined it is in the best interest of the Village to establish the position of staff sergeant within the Village Police Department and eliminate the position of lieutenant; now therefor


**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the position of lieutenant within the Village of Addyston Police Department is hereby eliminated.

SECTION 2. That no individual shall occupy or be promoted to a rank above staff sergeant within the Addyston Police Department, except for the position of chief of police, without the enactment of an ordinance creating a new position within the Addyston Police Department.

SECTION 3 That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the protection of the residents of the Village and the enforcement of ordinances within the Village.
