

VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2014- 13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON TO PARTICIPATE
IN THE SCIP FUNDING PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE CLERK
TO SIGN ALL APPLICATIONS NECESSARY FOR THE VILLAGE TO PARTICIPATE
IN THE SCIP FUNDING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Village of Addyston desires to participate in the SCIP Funding Program for the improvement of First Street in the Village of Addyston, Hamilton County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Addyston has consulted with its engineer concerning the improvement of First Street in the Village and determined the engineer's recommendation for the improvement of First Street is the best path for the Village's participation in SCIP Funding; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. The Village of Addyston shall make formal application and file all necessary paperwork for participation in the SCIP Funding Program as determined by the engineer in consultation with the Mayor of the Village of Addyston.

SECTION 2. The Village engineer shall prepare all necessary applications for the Village of Addyston to participate in the SCIP Funding Program.

SECTION 3. The Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized to sign all applications and/or paperwork on behalf of the Village of Addyston to participate in the SCIP Funding Program as prepared by the Village engineer.


SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to meet the imposed deadlines for participation in the SCIP Funding Program and to maintain streets within the Village for the passage of vehicular traffic.
