

VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2014- 18

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COMPENSATION
OF CERTAIN VILLAGE EMPLOYEES
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is appropriate to make adjustments in the rate of pay of certain Village employees; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the current rates of pay for the following specified positions shall be adjusted as follows:

Police Chief	(established by Ordinance 2014-10 on 9/4/2014)	\$24.72 per hour
Police Lieutenant	(this position was eliminated and replaced by staff sergeant)	
Police Staff Sergeant		18.53 per hour
Police Corporal		16.02 per hour
Part-Time Police Officers		14.94 per hour
Full-Time Maintenance Worker II		18.13 per hour
Full-Time Maintenance Worker I		16.00 per hour
Part-Time Maintenance Worker		12.25 per hour
Administrative Secretary of the Village		16.00 per hour
Substitute Secretary		11.84 per hour
Street Commissioner		311.27 per month
Substitute Secretary/Administrative Personnel		11.66 per hour

SECTION 2. That the rates of pay set forth at Section 1, above, shall take effect on November 4, 2014.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall supersede and take precedence over any previously enacted ordinance or legislation pertaining to the rates of pay of the above-listed employees as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. That, in addition to performing the regular duties of Chief of Police, the above-listed salary for the Chief of Police shall include the following: (a) attendance at meetings of the Village Council (no extra compensation shall be paid to the Chief of Police for such attendance), and (b) answering emergency calls when required (no extra compensation shall be paid to the Chief of Police for answering such calls).

SECTION 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to provide adequate and realistic compensation to the Village employees and elected officials in order to foster and facilitate their loyalty and availability.
