ORDINANCE NO. 2014-21

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES
OF THE VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON, OHIO DURING THE
CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2015

WHEREAS, Council is required to make temporary appropriations for the Village to continue the ordinarily and businesslike operation of the Village for the year 2015; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That to provide for the temporary expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Addyston during the calendar year ending December 31, 2015, the following sums be and are hereby set aside and appropriated:



SECTION 2. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certifications and vouchers therefor approved by the Board of Officers and/or Village Council authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of or in accordance with the law and ordinances; provided further that the appropriations for incidental expenses can only be expended for items of expense constituting a


legal obligation against the Village and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations made herein.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed forthwith and continue the orderly and businesslike operation of the Village.
