

VILLAGE OF ADDYSTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2015- 08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-703.1 OF  
THE ADDYSTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES  
FOR THE SIZE OF FRONT YARD FENCES

WHEREAS, when the Village Council enacted Section 15-703.1 of the Addyston Codified Ordinances fencing in the height of three feet was readily available from suppliers within the local area; and

WHEREAS, the housing inspector has notified Village Council that three feet fencing is no longer readily available with the local area; now therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That Section 15-703.1 of the Addyston Codified Ordinances shall be amended as follows:


Section 15-703.1: Fences, plant material and similar screening devices up to four (4) feet in height are permitted in yards fronting on the public street. These same screening devices up to six (6) feet in height are permitted in remaining yards.


**SECTION 2.** That all ordinances in conflict with the foregoing as to the height of fencing, plant material, and similar screening devices are repealed only to the extent the conflicting ordinance requires fences, plant material, and similar screening devices to be three (3) feet or less fronting on the public street.

**SECTION 3.** No fences, plant material, and similar screening devices shall obstruct the view of any street or intersection at any time.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to modify ordinances to make them compatible with the availability of product that meets the Village of Addyston ordinances.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2015-09**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND  
ESTABLISHING THE BOND RETIREMENT FUND**

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.05 (F) states that a municipality shall establish a special fund for each class of revenues derived from a source other than the general property tax which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose; now therefore


**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Addyston, State of Ohio:


**SECTION 1.** There is created a special fund for the Village of Addyston to be known as the RESERVE RUND. Subsidies from the General Fund, grants, donations or other sources specifically received for this purpose shall be deposited into this fund.

**SECTION 2.** Moneys deposited into the RESERVE FUND shall be disbursed by the Village as permitted and authorized by law or ordinance passed by Village Council authorizing the transfer, expenditure, or other appropriation of the monies in the RESERVE FUND.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to comply with Title 57 of the Ohio Revised Code.
