GUIDELINES

Brush and tree branches must be cut into manageable lengths and must be no larger than 12 inches in diameter. Brush and tree branches must be bundled. Bundles must not be heavier than 50 pounds.

Yard trimmings must be brought to locations in containers or bags - brown paper bags preferred. (Containers and plastic bags will be returned.)

Hamilton County residents only.

All materials dropped off at these sites will be composted or mulched.

The online access for viewing your account and paying your bill online website is ub-pay.com, you must register your account before access is granted. Residents please do not park on or otherwise cover or conceal water meter lids. If they are concealed, maintenance may have to dig to get to them.
