Mayor Lisa Mear called the special session of the village council to order at 6 PM. All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of our country. Ms. Wiehe stated that only two youth applications had been submitted with the parent/guardian attending the parent meeting. That the committee had agreed to raise the hourly pay rate based on the number of youths working. Therefore, the committee was recommending the hourly rate be increased to \$10.00 per hour. A motion was made by Mr. Pillow, seconded by Ms. Anderson to increase the hourly rate from \$8.00 t \$10.00 during the program, with the discussion and a Roll call vote: Six (6) Ayes motion carried.

Mr. Pillow presented Mayor and the other council members with a letter talking about the opportunity the village has to showcase our community. The letter is included in the minutes.
